Feast of St Ita (15th January)

Kileedy Parish is named for St Ita — one of the patron saint of our diocese. There is always a great celebration of St Ita's feast in her home parish!

St Ita was born in Waterford, but came to Kileedy where she led a community of sisters. She is sometimes called "the white sun of the women of Munster" or the "Brigid of Munster". Ita is also known as the "Foster Mother of the Saints of Ireland" because she was a mother figure to some of Ireland's early saints. St Brendan was in Killeedy for five years under the care of St Ita in the monastery at Killeedy from the time when he was a year old.
