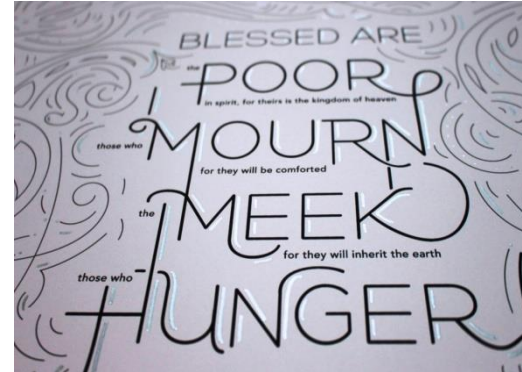
RECENTLY DECEASED
