RECENT FUNERAL

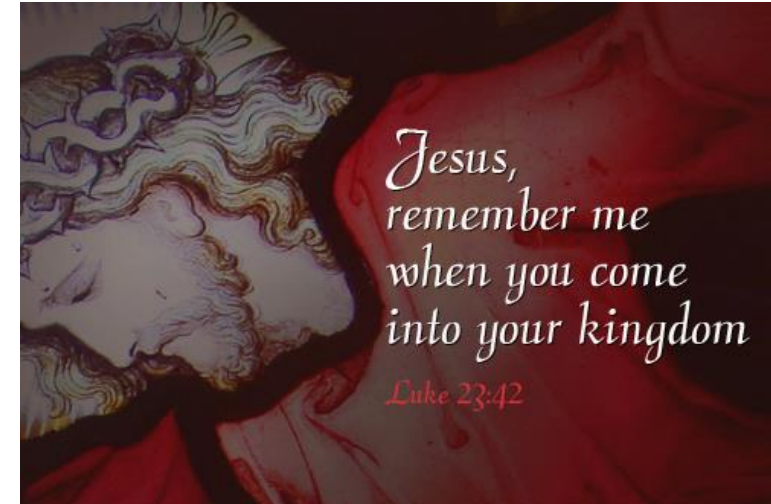
